

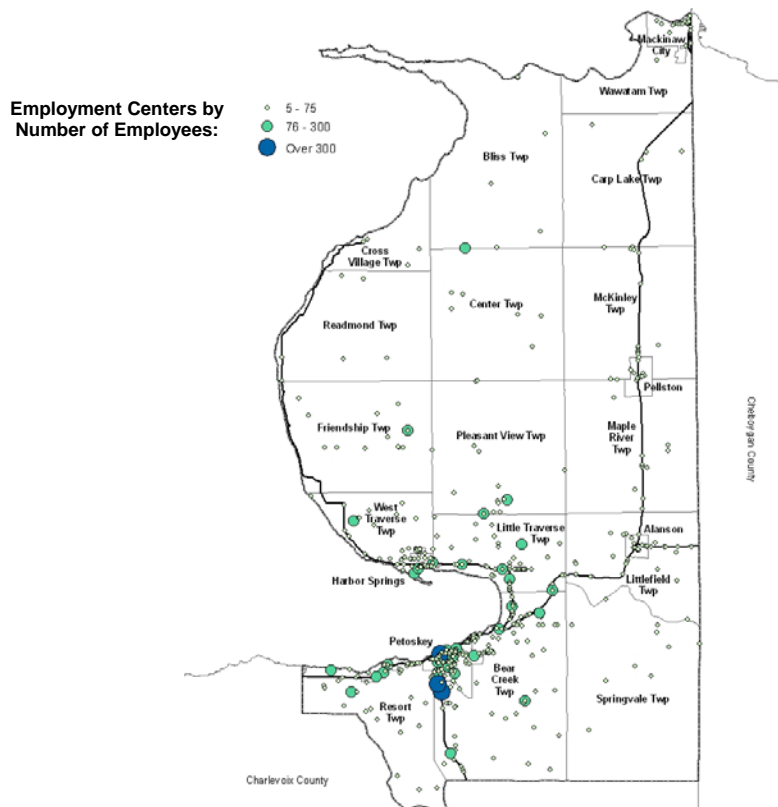
Emmet County
